RSM Foundation's Operational Grant


For a second year in a row, the **RSM Foundation** awarded a generous operational grant to Collective Success Network!

At seventeen years old, I was a FGLI student at Holy Family College, which is now Holy Family University in the greater northeast Philadelphia area. I graduated with my nursing degree in 1987, the only African American student in attendance at the graduation that year. I practiced nursing from 1987 to 2005, continued my education and transitioned into Leadership Development & Organizational Development.

How did you learn about CSN and how have you been involved?

I met Due Quach during my time at the Perelman School of Medicine and we quickly connected with us having similar experiences of growing up in inner city Philadelphia and being first generation college graduates.

Any special interest information (significant event or accomplishment)?

Submitted CSN as a candidate for a \$10,000 charity donation from Temple University Health Systems and recently found out that CSN will be the recipient of one of the ten \$10,0000 awards.
