Advocacy, Belong, and Careers (ABC) Program

CSN's new virtual Advocacy, Belonging and Careers (ABC) Program was piloted in July 2022, with six sessions and a keynote session from author **Elliot Felix.** The program was designed to help FGLI students advocate for themselves and others as they graduate from college and transition into the workforce.

The program, which was funded through a generous contribution from **RSM US LLP**, focused on how FGLI students could successfully make the transition from college into the workforce. Sessions included a range of diversity, equity, and inclusion issues in the workplace, such as how to navigate Crucial Conversations about topics like race and equity and how to give and receive constructive feedback to coworkers. At the end of the program, students wrote a policy brief on a topic of their choice and presented it to a "mock panel."


