to Peirce College and received a BS in Business Administration, an MS in Organizational Leadership from Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, and a Certificate in American Sign Language from Temple University.


2. How did you learn about CSN and why did you join the Advisory board?

I learned about the CSN program from a 2017 mentoring event at the African American Museum of Philadelphia. Due Quach was one of the speakers and told her story with some much passion that I needed to build a relationship alliance and work with her on her program. I was working at Drexel University at the time, so I was able to participate in their mentoring pods once I joined Temple University, we decided to create a first-gen student group to build further college connections. Once those projects were successful, Due can to me and spoke of a bigger commitment which included the Advisory Board. I joined because of her vision and the work I was able to accomplish with her at TempleU. The next step was to join the board.

3. Any special interest information (significant event or accomplishment)?

An American Psychological Association member, Dr. Adam J. Rodriquez reached out to first-generation scholars and educators to write about their experiences as the first in their families to graduate college. I wrote a chapter in 2021 and now the book will be released to the public on February 23rd. The book, Know That You Are Worthy: Experiences from First-Generation College Graduates shares the experiences of 31 scholars, educators, and HigherEd administrator's successes, failures, and tips and advice for first-gen students that will experience and offer mentoring advice and words of encouragement.

Cheryl graduated from Temple University in May 2022 with a degree in Tourism and Hospitality Management, concentrating in Event Leadership. From August 2019 to December 2021, Cheryl served as the President of Temple First's Collegiate Chapter!

"My journey from college into my career-hood started prematurely. In order to finish my degree, I have to take a 12 credit internship which is equivalent to a full time job for my last semester. I began searching during the fall semester of 2021, as the deadline approached I grew more desperate and sent out quite a few applications, only to receive rejection one after another. Until I receive a call from Marriott International with an offer to partake in their Voyager Program."

"The Voyager program takes undergraduate students and puts them in a management trainee program at different hotel brands. My journey started January 10th, 2022 at The Courtyard by Marriott. The start of my career was not what I imagined it to be. It was hard, especially because I was in an industry that I did not prepare myself for. I did not know a lot of the ins and outs of the

hotel industry and to suddenly work in one and learn how to manage a team was quite challenging."

"However, I persevered and I believe it was because of the support and lessons I learned while being part of the Collective Success Network. CSN showed me conversations regarding imposter syndrome and having individuals that understand feeling lost. They supported me through my journey and now as of this year, I moved on to a different property with Marriott at The Ritz Carlton as a Meetings and Special Events Coordinator."
