They touched on many important topics for CSN students: mentors, risk-taking, perseverance, reframing "failures" as "learnings", financial literacy, strategic career choices, and finding support team from family, colleagues, and/or friends.

Update on CSN's Student Leadership Development and Certificate Program

CSN's 2024 Student Leadership Program is well underway, with over twenty students from diverse colleges and universities across Philadelphia and surrounding areas. As usual, we had a waiting list, and we hope to be able to offer the program twice a year to accommodate everyone interested.

The first session focused on Improv, with Rick Horner. The second session focused on StrengthFinders2.0 with Keith Willis. The third session, which was facilitated by CSN Co-Founder Nancy Li, taught students about mindfulness and non-violent communication. This past week, students engaged in a session on Design Thinking. After next week's session on Crucial Conversations, students will make and share their own mini-Ted Talks on a topic of their choosing.

Here's a snapshot of student feedback about the value of the program!

About Improv:

 "As a leader, you have to be able to adapt. Leaders can look different and do things differently and you have to find your own style of being a leader."

About StrengthFinders2.0:

 "I think what was important about this session for FGLI students was knowing that they don't have to ignore their weaknesses. Any weakness can be useful in a situation, and knowing your weaknesses can help you overcome and improve them."

About Mindfulness and Non-Violent Communication:

 "Nonviolent communication requires the practice of empathy and active listening instead of assigning blame to others. Possessing this skill set is crucial for leaders to effectively address situations and achieve constructive outcomes rather than resorting to blame."

About Design Thinking:

 "As students from first-generation, low-income (FGLI) backgrounds, we're already defying expectations with the ideas and actions we bring forth. This session emphasized that, despite not seeing ourselves as major change agents, we're already breaking barriers and achieving things that might seem impossible."

CSN's Mentorship Program

CSN is wrapping up its signature Mentorship Program, which we have expanded to be a year-long program as opposed to a single semester. We hoped this change would give participants more time to build trust with their mentors and to create lasting relationships. Students who participated in the program who are still enrolled in school in the Fall can sign-up again. You can

work with your existing mentor or ask for a new one. Keep a lookout in the next newsletter for more information about the program and how to sign-up for Fall 2024.

- Aquatics / Lifeguard—Lifeguards at GSEP camps require an American Red Cross certification. This certification can be obtained upon arrival to camp.
- Managers—Each area of camp offers manager positions that are available to staff over the age of 21. These staff are usually experienced in camp operation or leadership.

Our Camps

Sleep-Away Camps run weeklong sessions where campers stay overnight from Sundays to Fridays. Staff are provided with three meals a day, access to laundry facilities, specialized training, and a place to stay for the entire summer.

 Camp Mosey Wood—White Haven, PA: In the Pocono Mountains, this camp provides a rustic Day Camps run weeklong sessions Monday through Friday. Campers are dropped off and picked up every day. Staff work 8-hour days with the option to work early and after care for additional compensation.

- Camp Valley Forge—Valley Forge, PA: This camp runs for 10 weeks throughout the summer.
 Campers spend their summer earning badges, swimming, and making tie dye!
- Camp Mountain House—Allentown, PA: 8 week program starting mid-June!
- Philly Camp—Roaming locations in Philadelphia.
 Summer 2024 will be hosted at the Community College of Philadelphia!
